PLAYER PERMIT POLICY

The Wagga Tigers Junior Football Netball Club promotes development of its own players. The Local Permit System allows players from one league to play under a permit to a club in another league for the purpose of supporting those teams who find it difficult to field a full side each week.

The Club believes player numbers at WTFNC are currently sufficient not to warrant players from outside the club.

The club has adopted the following Policy in relation to Permit Players:

- No players will be permitted to play in a competitive team on a permit from another club (u12's-u15's).
- If extenuating circumstances exist (i.e. a particular team has low players numbers less than 15 registered players) a coach may provide a written case to the Club outlining the reason permit players are required as well as the players involved and their club or origin.
- The case must be put before a full committee meeting at the start of a month for consideration.
- Only under extenuating circumstances will the club allow a permit player to play in a finals series.

The Club has decided it would prefer to develop players in a younger age division rather than players that are external to the club. Each case for extenuating circumstances will be determined based on its merit and any case put forward by a coach will need to demonstrate that they are unable to source the required players from the age division below.
